

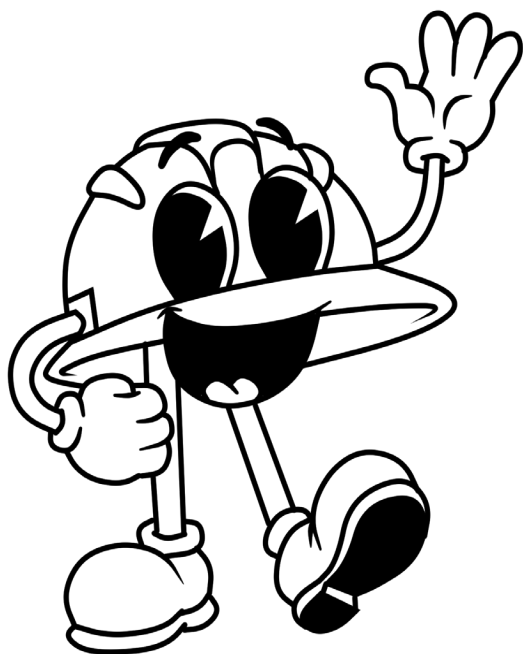

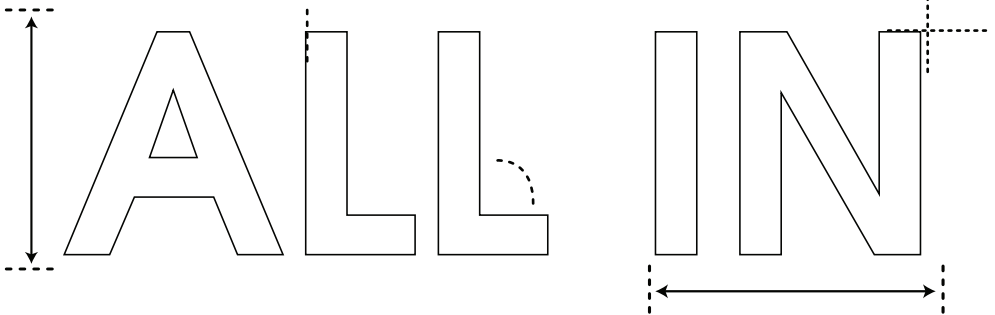

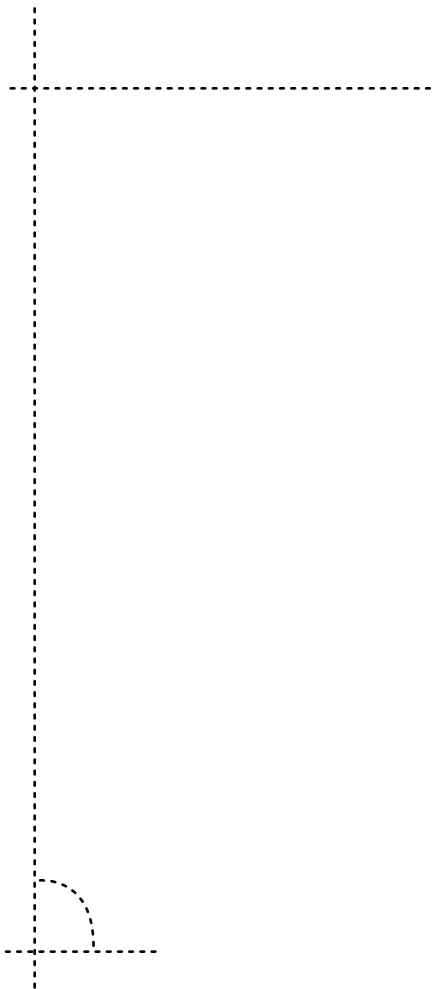
At BCC, we're aiming for 100% participation in our **All In** Project—kids included! To help explain what's next and answer any questions your kids might have, we've created a fun rhyme.

Thank you for sharing this with your kids. They're vital to our church's mission, and we want them to understand and feel part of this exciting chapter at Blount Community Church.





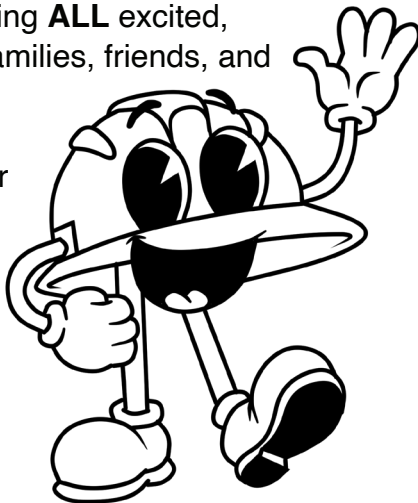

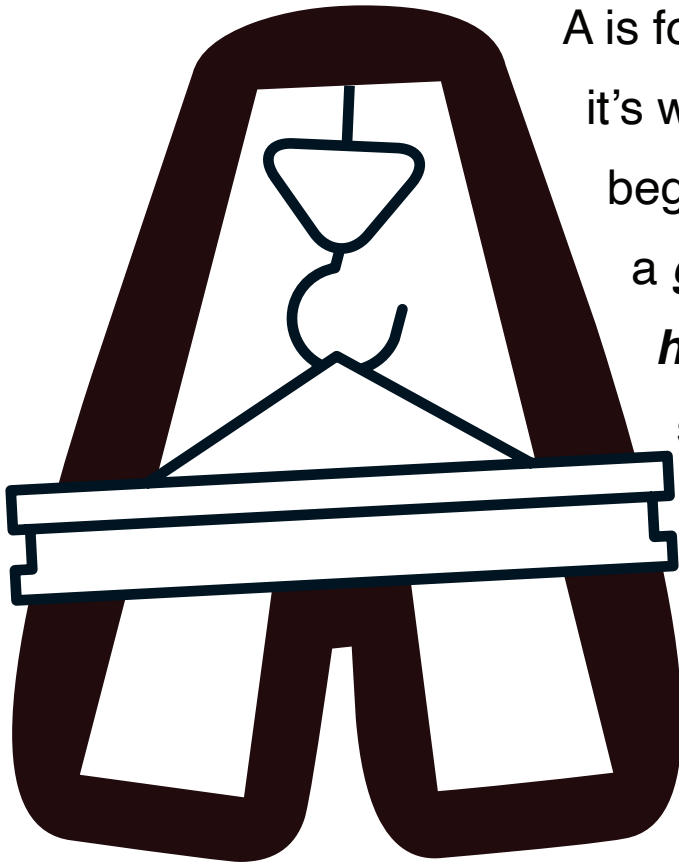
I'm **ALL**-vin, your friendly building buddy! I'm here to get you **ALL** IN on the most exciting adventure of **ALL**—our new church building project!

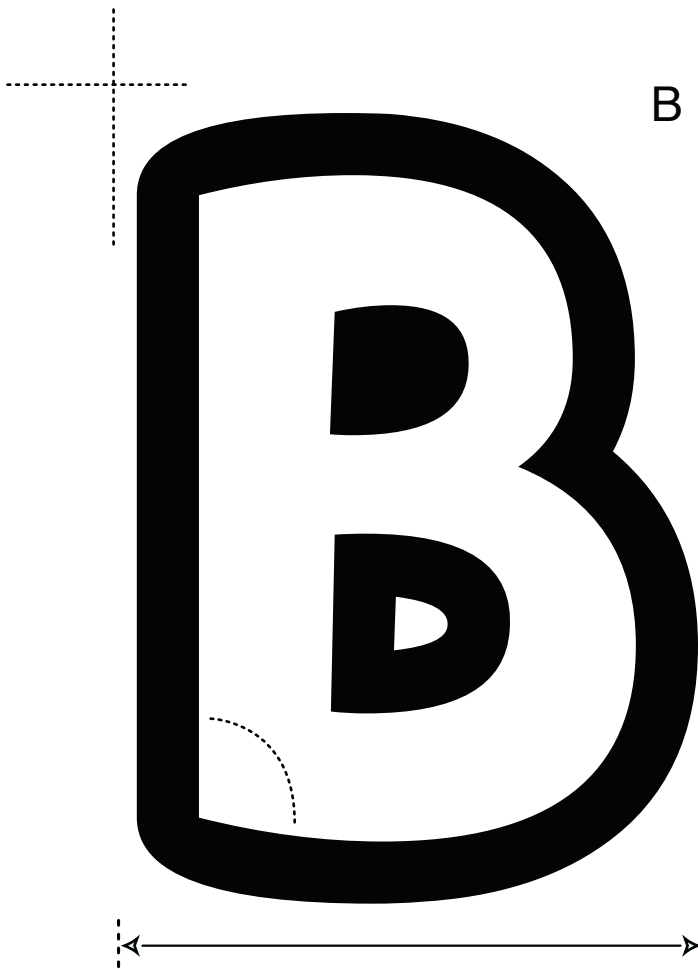

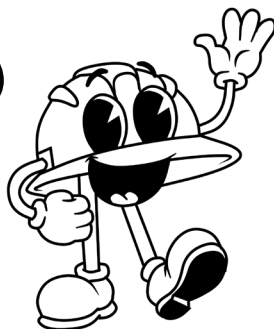


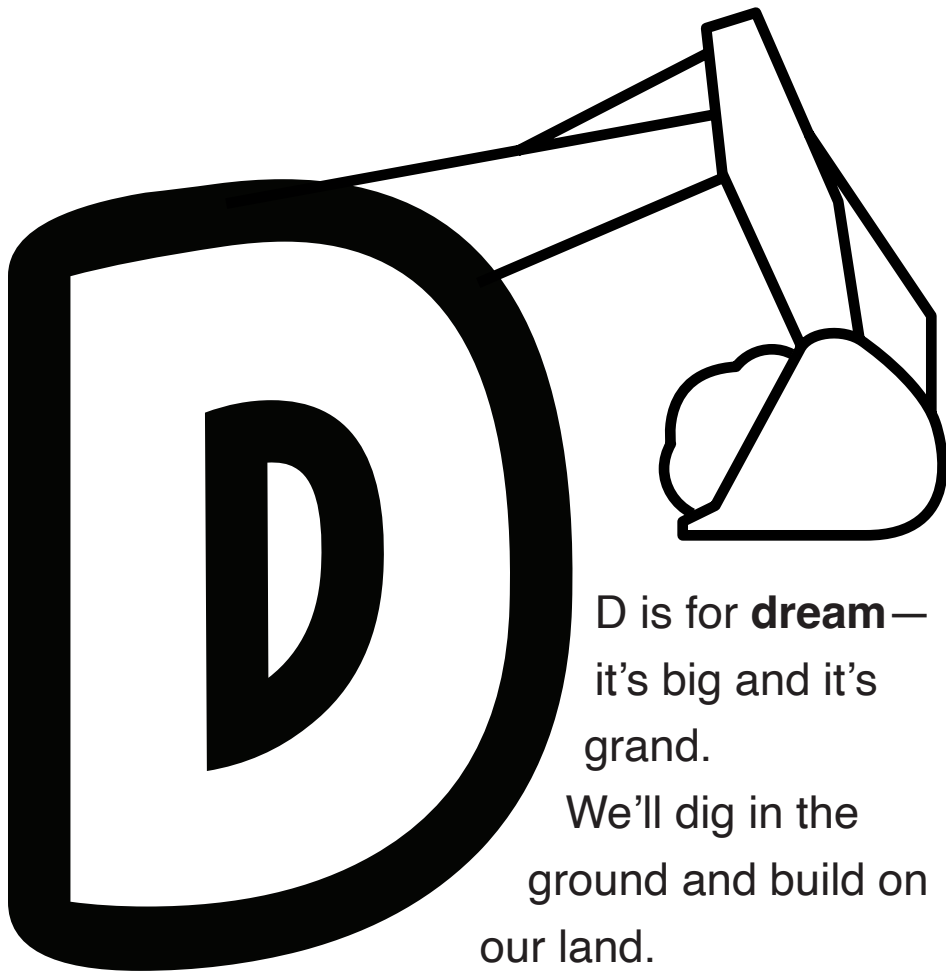
B is for **building**,

too.**



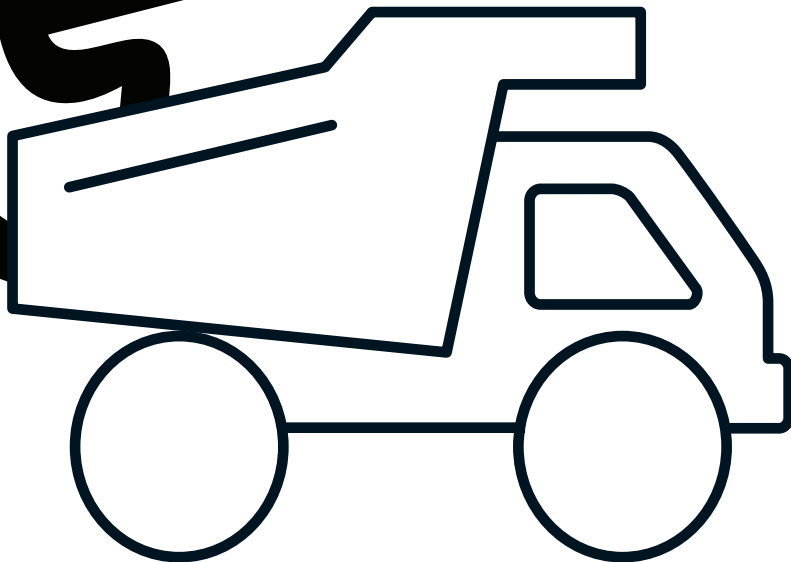


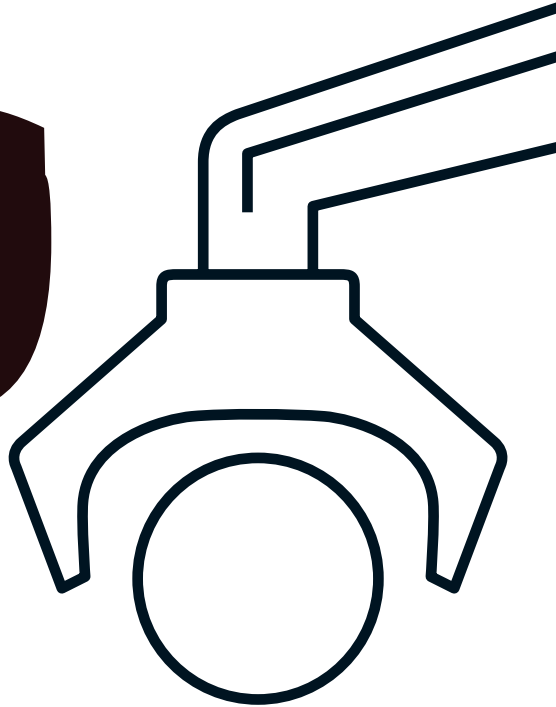
D is for **dream** —

our land.

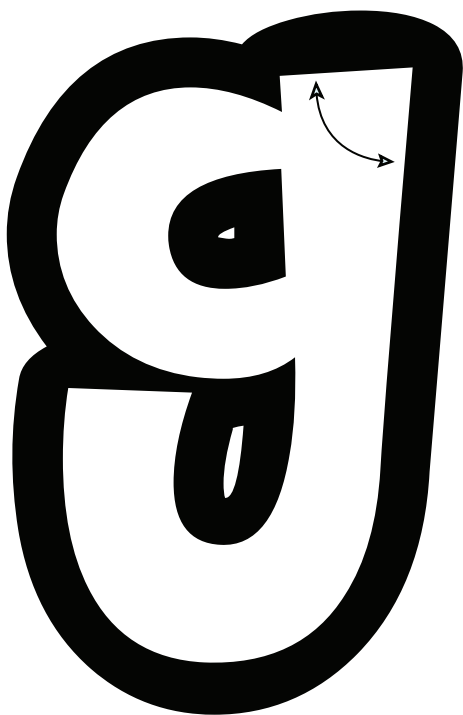


E is for **everyone**...

means yours too!



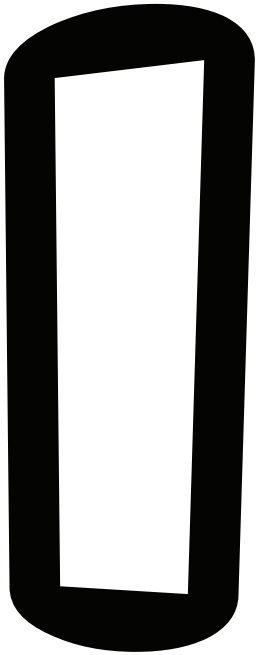
G is for **giving**,

spot.

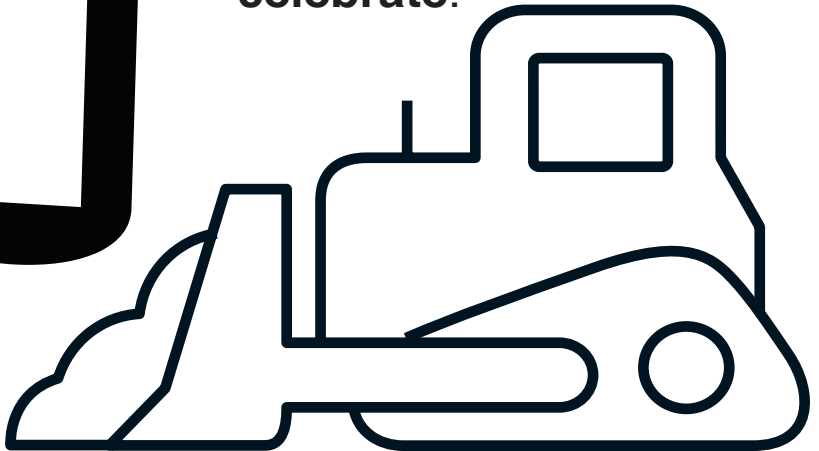


H is for **hard work**, as we all

planned.



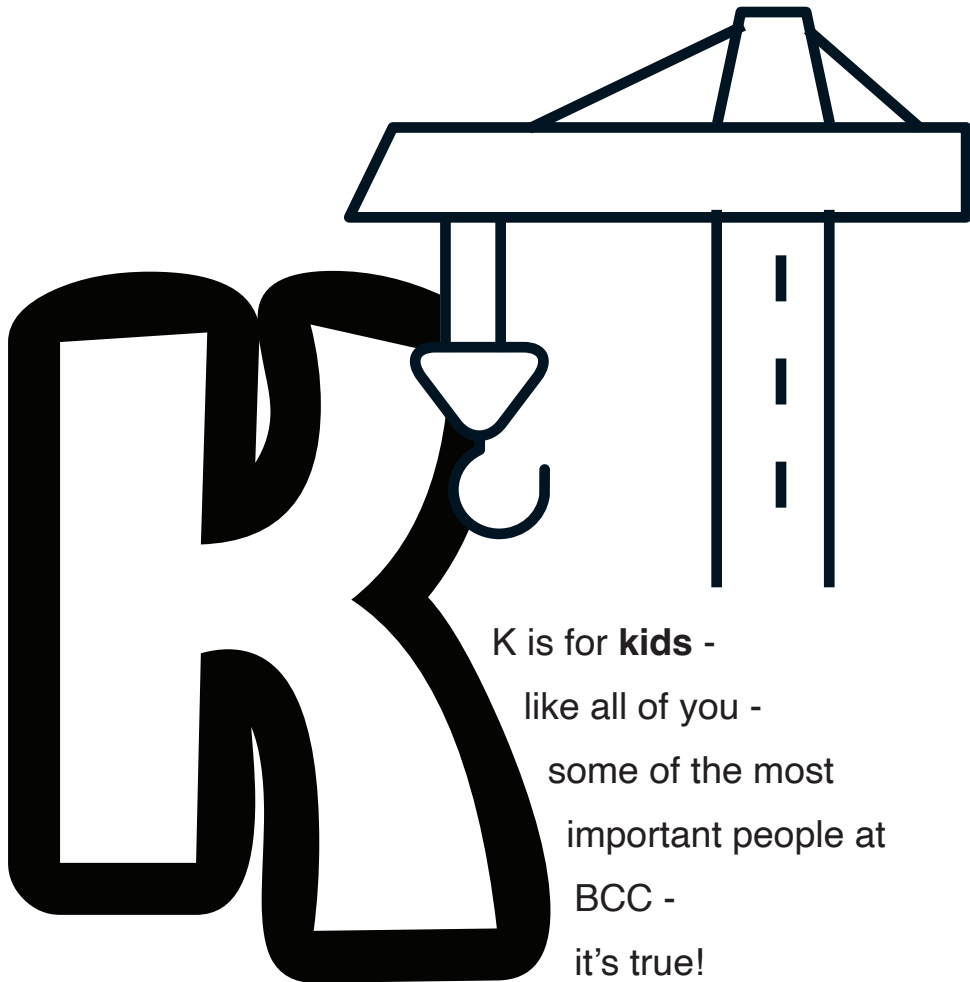


I is for **imagine** the future

celebrate.

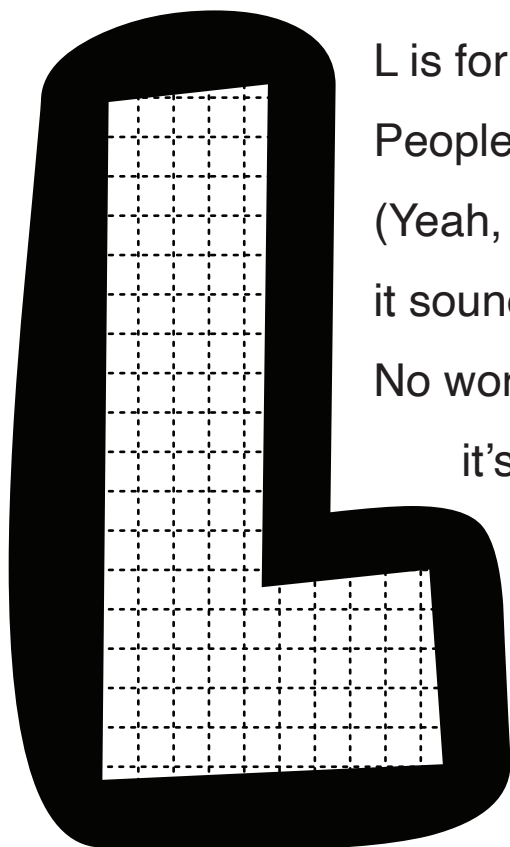


J is for **joy**, as our

L is for **love**—we Love

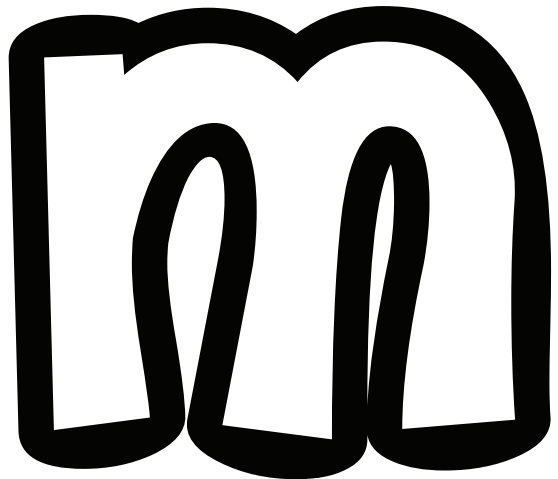
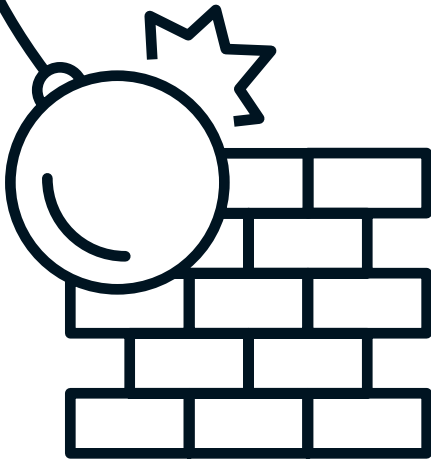

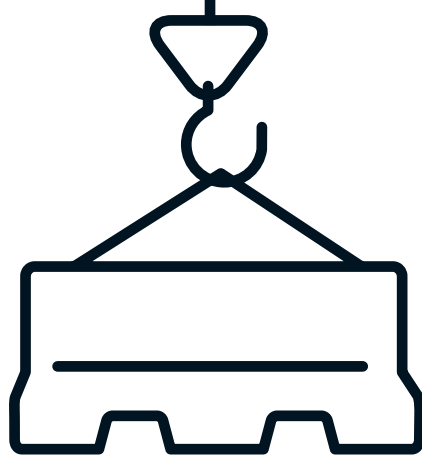

so here's more. **Others**

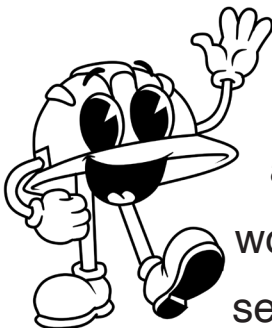

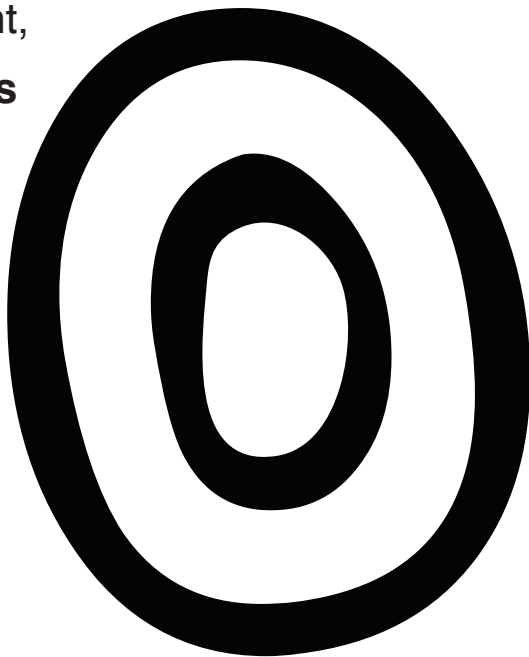

God is doing is right.**

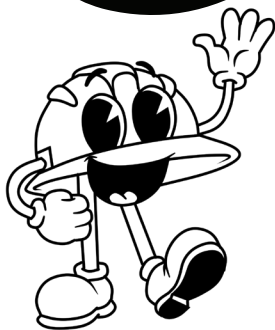
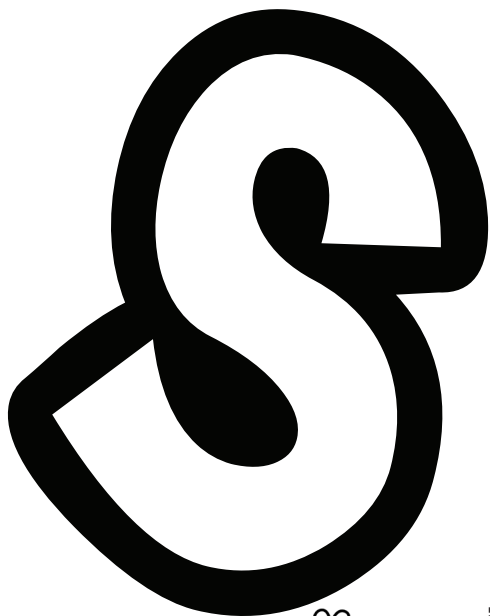
Q is for **questions** -

place!”

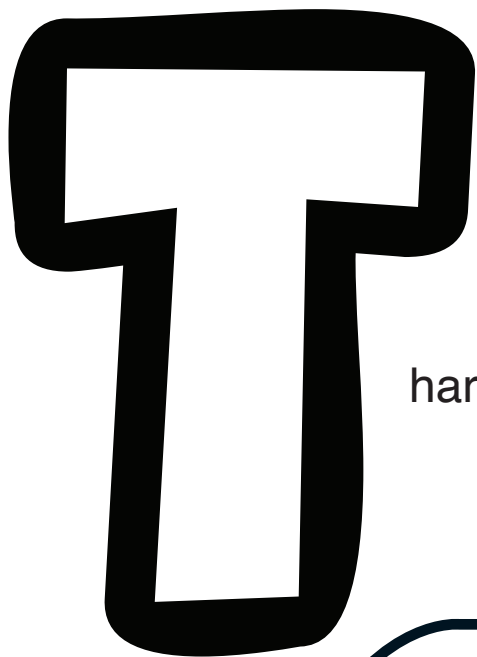




Well, R is for a **reason**,

know?

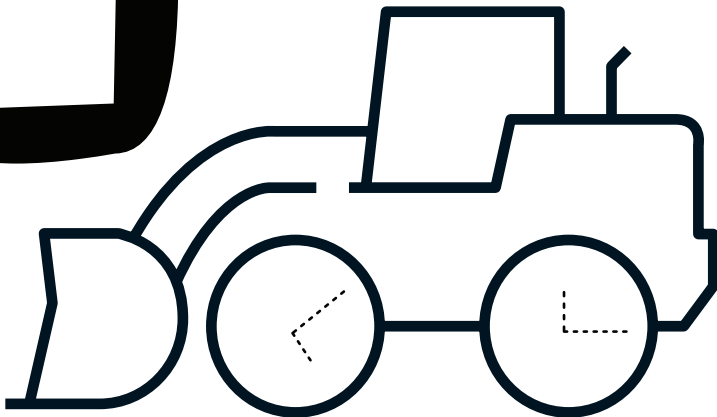


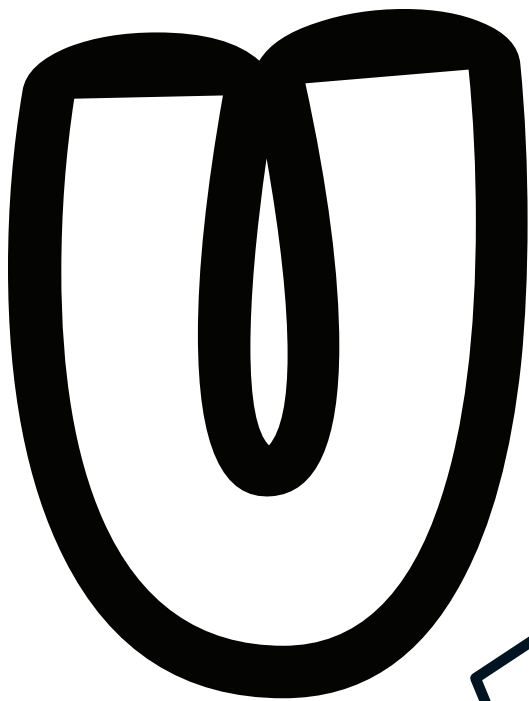
S is for **space** - and

take.



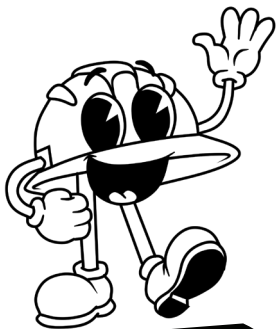


U is for **us**, we're
