




At BCC, we're aiming for 100% participation in our **All In** Project—kids included! To help explain what's next and answer any questions your kids might have, we've created a fun rhyme.

Thank you for sharing this with your kids. They're vital to our church's mission, and we want them to understand and feel part of this exciting chapter at Blount Community Church.








I'm **ALL**-vin, your friendly building buddy! I'm here to get you **ALL** IN on the most exciting adventure of **ALL**—our new church building project!

It's going to be All-some.






B is for **building**, it's where we all meet. Something special's happening and, that's pretty **neat**. C is for **community**—what's at our core, it's in our name, and it means so much more.


Community means people—our neighbors and friends - and loving them is where our story

Blount County is growing - and that's not new - but the growing is happening at our church, too.











G is for **giving**, to help this plan grow, God's called us to give, if you did not know.


Because building more space will take a whole lot— our builders and workers will hit the spot.






J is for joy, as our dreams take flight. We'll see our new space come together just right.

O is for **others** - that's who this is for.


This part's so important, so here's more. Others is anyone that is not **you** - and a bigger building means space for what God's called us to do - like small



serving, it's true.










